Singapore Cooperation Programme

Singapore has provided technical assistance to other developing countries since the 1960s. As a country whose only resource is its people, Singapore believes that human resource development is vital for economic and social progress. Singapore itself has benefited from training provided by other countries and international organisations.

In 1992, the Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) was established to bring together under one framework the various technical assistance programmes offered by Singapore. Through the SCP, the range and number of training programmes were increased to share Singapore's development experience with other developing countries.

To date, close to 150,000 officials from more than 180 countries, territories and intergovernmental organisations have participated in our courses and study visits. The SCP is managed by the Technical Cooperation Directorate of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Singapore.

Course Objectives

This online course is conducted under the auspices of the SCP Training Award.

This course will share Singapore's experience in public sector leadership, economic development, good governance strategies and human capital development.

Synopsis

Topics to be covered include:

- Singapore's approach to governance and public service transformation
- Economic development strategies and financial budgetary processes
- Good governance and public accountability

Methodology

This course will be conducted in English for up to 30 participants through synchronous e-learning ('live' e-learning sessions), and could include asynchronous e-learning (self-study e.g. reading materials). There will be Q&A sessions and facilitated group discussions during the 'live' e-learning sessions.

Course Duration

The course will be held over five days from 11 to 15 March 2024.

The 'live' e-learning sessions will be tentatively conducted from 1400H to 1800H (Singapore time; UTC/GMT +08:00 hours) daily. The programme schedule will be provided to successful applicants closer to the start of course.

Attendance will be taken for the 'live' e-learning sessions.

Application Information

Applicants should be:

- Mid- to senior-level government officials involved leadership and strategic planning work;
- Able to attend all the synchronous e-learning sessions (participants will require an internet-enabled device with Zoom installed, webcam, microphone and audio);
- Nominated by their respective governments; and
- Proficient in written and spoken English.

Course Sponsor

The online course is sponsored by the Government of Singapore under the Singapore Cooperation Programme Training Award.

Regulations

Participants are required to comply with the following:

- Strictly observe course schedules and not miss training sessions; and
- Carry out instructions and abide by conditions as may be stipulated by the nominating authority or government and the Government of Singapore and its appointed trainer, with respect to the course.
